Wayne Gdovic, Superintendent of the South Allegheny School District, was contacted regarding the possibility of SA students fabricating murals in Glassport.

John is waiting for information and pricing for Phil Sopp signs regarding the replacements of the welcome signs at both end of Glassport on Monongahela Ave.

The members approved a donation to the Glassport Children's Christmas party in the amount of \$50.00 and a donation to the New Horizons Majorette Corp in the amount of \$25.00.
