Meeting Minutes

Parliamentary:

The meeting convened at 6:00 p.m. with the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Report: Secretary-Ann Ostroski

John D'Angelo reviewed with the members the minutes of the previous meetings meeting which were approved. Ann was absent.

Open Report:

Mayor Evanovich summarized information regarding the proceedings of some of the Glassport properties that have been cited for violations. Some of the property owners who are negligent in have been taken before the magistrate for code enforcement including the owner of the 9th and Ohio property and the owner of Chuck's Hubcaps.

He noted that the Borough is to receive a \$200,000 grant for the destruction of abandoned, unsalvageable properties.

John discussed the community event that will be hosted by the GDC. He report included, but was not limited to the following:

- It was decided that the event will be one day and include a combined car and craft show. The date is to be Saturday, September 7, 2013 with a rain date of September 8th.
- The plan is to block off Monongahela from 5th to 8th Streets. John will attend the next Glassport Council workshop to present the idea and information to Council members for approval.
- Mark Davies presented John with a list of companies that provide free items for "grab bags" for car shows. The local bars will request that the beer and spirit companies provide free items such as t-shirts, mugs, and pens.
- Dave Kowalski volunteered to fabricate fliers to place distribute at other car shows to promote the GDC event.
- Mayor Evanovich agreed to donate \$50.00 towards the "car trophies".
- Pat Kmetz and Andrea Foster are to co-chair the craft vendor part of the community event.
- It was agreed that the event will be named the Glassport Community Car Cruise and Craft Show, with this year's being named the 1st annual.
- Dan Matta of Matta's Motors has agreed to purchase the car dash plaques.

- Mark Kapsha will donate his time and the use of his equipment to provide music as a D.J. for the event.
