*JOHN D IS WORKING WITH WAYNE LEWIS FIRE CHIEF TO GET A GRANT FOR THE FIRE DEPT FOR A GENERATOR FOR THE FIRE HALL. THAT BLDG IS THE DESIGNATED BOROUGH DISASTER SHELTER. THE FIREMEN WILL EDUCATE THE CITIZENS ON THE FIRE SIREN WHICH IS ALSO A DISASTER WARNING SIREN. IT WILL SOUND DIFFERENT THAN A FIRE SIREN. THEY WILL TEST IT EVERY WEEK TO GET PEOPLE USED TO THE DIFFERENT WARNINGS.

* MM/ROSEMARY BRADLEY SECOND BY STEVE GARY THAT THE G D C CONTACT DUQUESNE LIGHT TO GET THE BOROUGH IN ON THE PROGRAM TO CONVERT STREET LIGHTS TO L E D LIGHTS. WE QUALIFY FOR MINIMUM OF 10 LIGHTS

* SHOWED GLASSPORT MIDDLE SCHOOL FOR SECOND TIME TO RODRIGUEZ INVESTMENT GROUP. THEY REQUESTED PLANS TO BE SENT TO THEM SO THAT THEY CAN HAVE THEIR ARCHITECT WORK UP A PLAN AND MAKE A RENDERING OF THE FINISHED BUILDING FOR

SENIOR HOUSING. THEY WILL THEN NEGOTIATE WITH THE SCHOOL BOARD FOR ACQUISITION OF THE BUILDING. THEY HAVE THE DRAWING AS WE MEET.

VP REPORT: MARK IS WORKING ON THE CAR SHOW. HE IS CURRENTLY WORKING ON A TEE SHIRT DESIGN AS WELL AS THE WEB SITE UPDATES. MARK DISCUSSED BRINGING IN MORE LIVE ENTERTAINMENT FOR THE CAR SHOW BUT IS WAS POINTED OUT THAT IT WOULD TAKE AWAY FROM THE PURPOSE OF THE CAR SHOW, HOWEVER WE DISCUSSED HAVING ENTERTAINMENT AT THE MEMORIAL PARK SUCH AS AN OPEN MIKE NIGHT OR "MUSIC IN THE PARK". MARK AGREED TO LOOK INTO IT AND ROSEMARY BRADLEY SAID THE BOROUGH SHOULD LOOK INTO FUNDING SOMETHING LIKE THIS.
