* PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

* JOHN MET WITH ROBERT LASSER OF PENNTEX VENTURES LLC ABOUT DEVELOPING THE PROPERTY BEHIND THE HONOR ROLL. PRESENTED HIM WITH AN ARTIST'S CONCEPTION OF THE PROPOSED SUPERMARKET ON SAID PROPERTY. HAD A LENGTHY DISCUSSION ON SAME. IDEAS WERE EXCHANGED AND A FUTURE MEETING WILL BE CONDUCTED. WE ALSO GAVE A COPY OF THE ARTIST'S DRAWING TO RODRUIGEZ INVESTMENTS FOR THEIR EFFORTS TO ASSIST IN BRINGING IN A SUPERMARKET TO GLASSPORT.

* JOHN D'ANGELO MET WITH JOHN PALYO OF C O G AN D STEVE PHOLAR OF WEST TO WEST COALITION TO DISCUSS THE APPLICATION FOR A C I T F GRANT FOR THE LEARN TO OWN PROGRAM FOR GLASSPORT. FINAL ARRANGEMENTS WERE MADE TOWARD COMPLETION OF THE GRANT APPLICATION.
